Statement of Policy

It is the policy of the company that its operations are executed at all times in such a way as to ensure as far as is reasonably practicable the health and safety of all its employees and all persons likely to be affected by its operations, including subcontractors, licensees and the public where appropriate.

This policy is the direct concern of the company directors who are accountable for its overall implementation. In particular, Mr. E. Robertson, Managing Director of Glendale Electrical, has overall responsibility for ensuring the effective development and implementation of the firm's safety policy and procedures.

It is a function of management to provide the right circumstances under which work may be carried out safely. However, all employees must be aware that they have a duty, not only to work in a safe manner, but also to co-operate in efforts made to create safe working conditions.

The policy document details the chain of safety responsibility from Director level to site or workshop. Those responsibilities applicable to the person concerned are issued with this statement.

Action to be taken to control specific hazards and instructions on compliance with applicable regulations and codes of practice will be issued from time to time for inclusion in files of safety instructions. Training or guidance will be given to employees on how to recognise and guard against foreseeable hazards and how to meet the responsibilities placed on them.

This company has a good health and safety record. The co-operation of every employee to fulfil their legal obligations is necessary in order that standards may be maintained or improved whenever possible.
